



Inn at Barnsley Resort and Georgian Hall Set to Debut March 2018

ADAIRSVILLE, GA - November 2017 – Georgia’s award-winning [Barnsley Resort](#) will debut the 55-room Inn at Barnsley Resort, as well as Georgian Hall, adding more than 9,000 square feet of indoor space, in March 2018 to meet the increasing demand from the groups, meetings and weddings segments.

The executive team noted that the Inn will offer the convenience of having all attendees within the same building, as well as expand opportunities to host larger groups. Upon completion of the Inn and Georgian Hall, Barnsley Resort will offer 150 guest rooms and an impressive 16,000 square feet of total indoor meeting space.

Inn at Barnsley Resort

Inspired by the works of noted British architect Edwin Lutyens, known for significant English country homes from the turn of the 20th century, the Inn at Barnsley Resort will feature stained and hand-scraped hardwood floors, exposed beams, and scattered area rugs. A new guest registration area and adjacent Living Room will serve as a relaxed gathering area for guests. A grand staircase and fireplace will be focal points, along with a boutique retail option. The Inn will feature spacious bedrooms ranging from 378 to 528 square feet with a mix of king and double queen beds. The third floor will offer additional features such as dormer windows, sloped ceilings and window seats.

Georgian Hall

The Georgian Hall will bring new indoor space to host corporate meetings, weddings and other special events in a picture-perfect location. Georgian Hall’s exterior complements the existing Rice House restaurant, located within in a 19th century farmhouse. The Savannah Ballroom will offer 4,700+ square feet of space and accommodate up to 500 guests in a theater set-up and 380 seated banquet-style. The design will feature vaulted ceilings, stained hand-scraped scissor trusses, painted millwork, dormer windows, and a memorable floor-to-ceiling fireplace. The Savannah Terrace will offer outdoor space for up to 215 guests at one end of the ballroom. Additional meeting and event space will include the Dalton Room, Georgian Veranda, a covered veranda for receptions and gatherings, and the Estate Lawn, equipped with full lighting and sound capabilities.
